RMD Australia is committed to ensuring that all of our employees will be kept safe from injury and risk to health while at work. In order to comply with our policy we will:

- ↪ Comply with relevant health and safety legislation
- ↪ Develop and maintain a positive attitude towards health and safety awareness by all employees based on an understanding of hazard and risk
- ↪ Commit to continually improve safety in the workplace through the establishment, monitoring and review of safety targets and objectives
- ↪ Consult with employees in matters relating to occupational health, safety and welfare through the establishment of Safety Committees and conducting regular communications meetings
- ↪ Provide training to ensure the awareness of workplace hazards and the implementation of appropriate controls
- ↪ Maintain records of training, consultation and communication of safety matters
- ↪ Ensure that sub-contractors on our premises comply with our policy and procedures
- ↪ Ensure responsibilities for safety are maintained as per the Divisional Health and Safety Policy
- ↪ Periodically review this policy to ensure it remains relevant and appropriate to the organization
- ↪ Broadly communicate that all employees have an obligation to protect theirs' and their fellow employees safety

The implementation of this policy is the responsibility of all employees with the appropriate assistance of management. This policy is fully authorised by the Board of Directors of RMD Australia.
